Position: Alternate Delegate

Prerequisite: Be a member in good standing with the IMSA International, IMSA Ontario Trillium Section, and has served on the Ontario Section Board, as a director, for at least 3 terms.

Term: The Alternate Delegate shall be elected by the members at the AGM for a two (2) year term. The Delegate shall remain in the position until such time as he/she is no longer a member in good standing of the IMSA Ontario Trillium Section or resigns from the position.

Amount of time required for position: The Alternate Delegate should attend meetings when required of the Ontario section, so he/she is aware of the ongoing activities within the section. Given most of our meetings are usually 2 hours, then the Alternate Delegate would have to commit to about 10 hours per year.

Duties The Alternate Delegate has no official duties but must be prepared to assume the position of the International Delegate should that position become vacant for any reason. The Alternate Delegate must be very familiar with the duties of the International Delegate.

Position Description of the Delegate The Alternate Delegate should be very knowledgeable about the operation of his/her own section and somewhat familiar with the operation of the International Board.
