Position: International Delegate

Prerequisite: Be a member in good standing with the IMSA International, IMSA Ontario Trillium Section, and has served on the Ontario Trillium Section Board as a Director for at least three (3) terms.

Term: The International Delegate shall be elected by the members at the AGM for a two (2) year term. The Delegate shall remain in the position until such time as he/she is no longer a member in good standing of the IMSA Ontario Trillium Section or resigns from the position.

Amount of time required for position: The Delegate must attend all meetings called by the chair of the Delegates committee. The Delegate is required to attend the International Conference held annually, usually somewhere in the United States. On occasion, there can be a Delegates meeting scheduled at the Mid-winter meeting which is usually in February. On occasion there can be a meeting called for at any time by the Chair of the delegates committee which is usually a virtual meeting. The Annual Conference is usually about four (4) days and the Mid Winter meeting is usually two (2) days so total time required for the position would be somewhere around six (6) days per year. Often there are other meetings scheduled at the conference which the Delegate should attend on behalf of the section.

Duties The Delegate must attend either in person or virtual (for meetings other than the Annual Conference or the Mid-winter meeting) for all meetings called by the Chair of the Delegates. The information gathered at ANY Delegates meeting should be conveyed to the Ontario Trillium Section at the next meeting.

Position Description of the Delegate The Delegate should be very knowledgeable about the operation of their section and somewhat familiar with the operation of the International Board.
